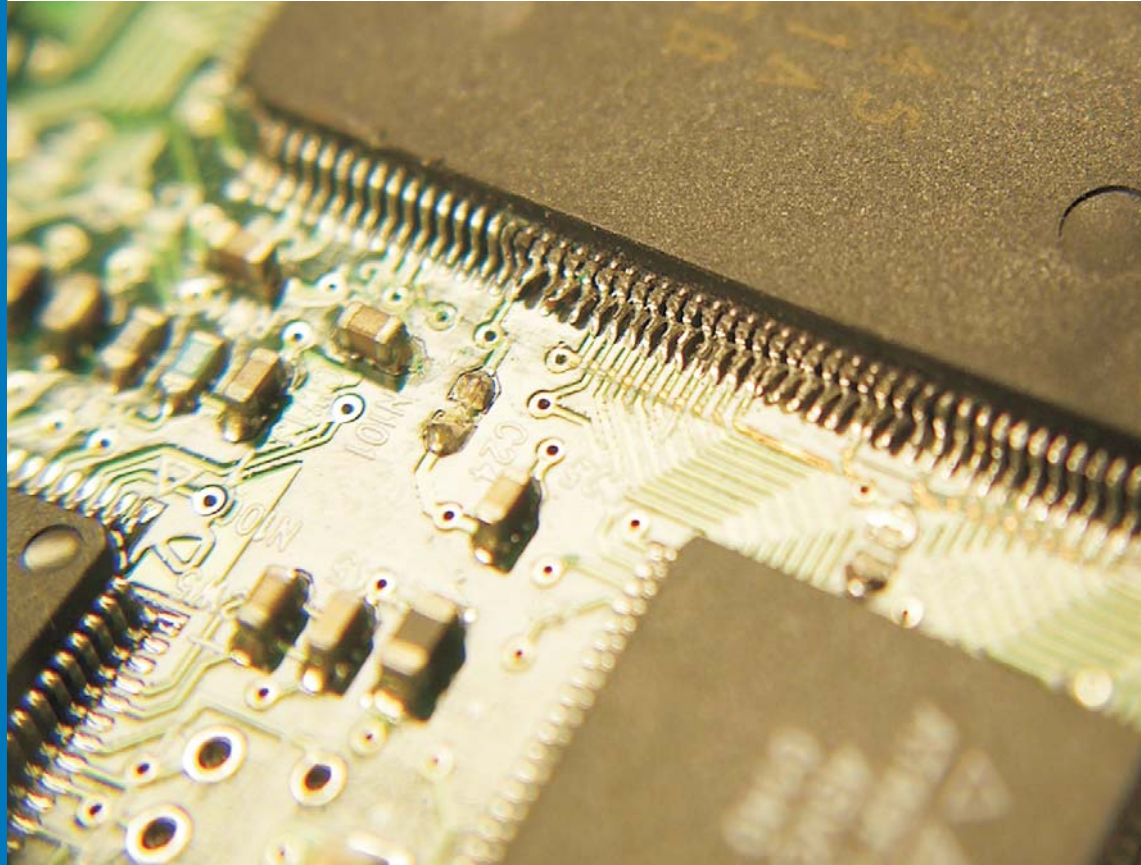

The following main areas will be discussed:

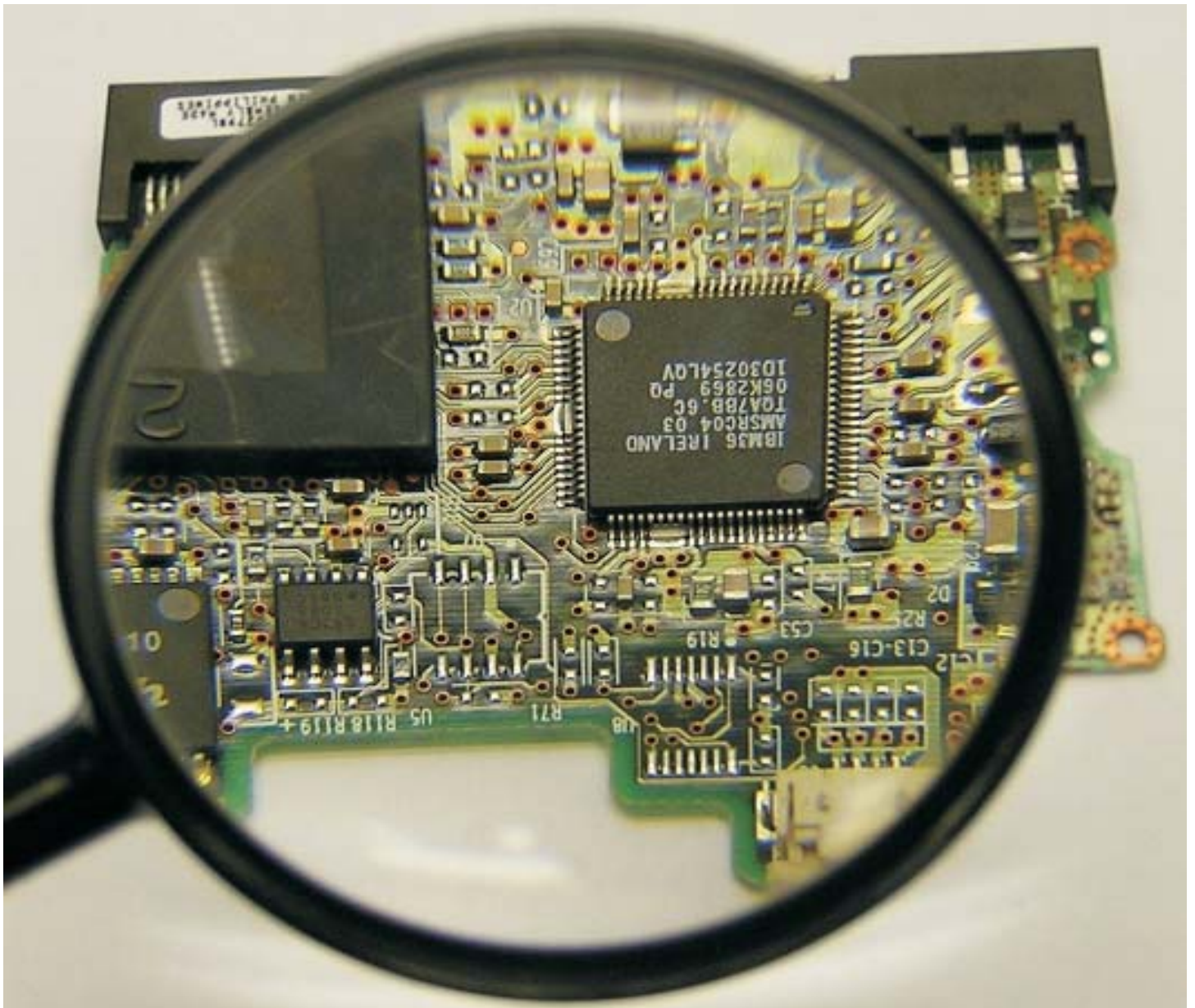
1. Effective management of forensic examination

Technical aspects and ways of solving main problems
